

IMPORTANT – NEW INFORMATION
HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION DAY
Saturday, May 13, 2017, 8 a.m. – 2 p.m.
Brush Dump, Corner of Parsonage and Drinkwater Roads

HOUSEHOLD WASTE COLLECTION DAYS

DUMP STICKERS: Beginning with the spring Household Waste Collection Day scheduled for **Saturday, May 13**, 8 a.m. to 2 p.m., Dump Permit Stickers are no longer *required* to participate. Residents will now be charged a \$10 per trip fee, with proof of residency. Please note that fees apply to certain items accepted for disposal.

Three-year Dump Permit Stickers previously purchased by residents
will be honored until expiration.

DISPOSAL OF BRUSH: Those who utilize the **Brush Dump** for disposal of leaves, brush and slash five (5) inches or less in diameter will still need to obtain a \$30 **three-year Dump Permit Sticker** from the Town Clerk's office during scheduled business hours or on-line at http://hamptonfalls.org/Pages/HamptonFallsNH_Clerk/dump. This requirement is due, in part, so that the Dump Attendant does not need to handle money.

NEW - DISPOSAL OF HOUSEHOLD GENERATED WOOD: Beginning with the 2017 spring Household Waste Collection Day, clean, untreated wood that is able to be burned will be accepted for disposal for a fee.

*Please note that disposal of household generated wood and
electronics is only available at the spring collection day.*

DISPOSAL OF MERCURY PRODUCTS AND BATTERIES:

Mercury Products: fluorescent lamps, thermostats, mercury switches, button cell batteries may be disposed in the shed at the Brush Dump provided for this purpose during Household Waste Collection Days and Brush Disposal Saturdays.

Batteries: alkaline and lithium batteries may be disposed in the shed at the Brush Dump. This option is provided for proper disposal to prevent potential spark or ignition.

PROHIBITED OVERALL: *Stumps, commercial, industrial,
construction and remodeling demolition and hazardous waste.*

*An exception to this is a minimum amount of (less than 1/2 pickup truck load) household renovation
debris that is acceptable for disposal at the spring Household Waste Collection Day.*
