

Hampton Falls Heritage Commission  
Draft Meeting Minutes  
August 4, 2014

Present: David French, Chair, Beverly Mutre, Secretary, Maryann Kasprzak, Selectwoman, Wendy Harrington, Commissioner. Mary Ann Hill, Commissioner, a later arrival. The meeting commenced at 6:55 pm.

The minutes from July were reviewed. A motion to accept with amendment to add an adjournment statement was made by B.Mutrie, seconded by M. Kazprzak and it was voted in favor by D. French and W. Harrington.

Update from Lynne Monroe, Preservation Co.-- We tried to discern who would know about changes to the Town Hall. W. Harrington mentioned that several people talked about the stage in the 300th video. Paul Vatcher, Bobbi Pevear, Carolyn Petit or Anne Coombs should be contacted. B. Mutrie and M. Hill will start reviewing the town reports and Selectmen's minutes to find info. M. Kaszprzak thought that the stage was removed between 1966 and 1974.

Peter Michaud of the NH Div. Historic Resources will be contacted by D. French re the Unitarian Church moving its foundation.

Tilton-Merrill property-- roof being redone. B. Mutrie spoke with the manager of the bicycle business (Ron Deshaies) and he and the owner (Philbrick) are interested in keeping the house and barn. There is a dry well of sorts right next to the road near the end of the barn. Should contact Mark S. B. Mutrie also reported that the fireplace surrounds were removed sometime after the auction. D. French has pictures.

We have been asked to find out info on 142 Kensington Road...Small house. Now belongs to Anthony Faille. It supposedly was moved from Rye to Hampton Falls. It is old and has a small barn/garage. According to the tax card it was built about 1825 (21x32 main house).

W. Harrington has downloaded A Billion Graves AP and will be going to a cemetery to use it to upload cemetery data.

Blue Chip Farm is still occupied with the barn being fixed up.

Leo Cronin's house (Aberdeen Lodge) on Exeter Road will be auctioned off tomorrow. Fran Rice will be selling her house also.

September meeting will be cancelled and perhaps rescheduled.

A motion to adjourn from M. Kasprzak was heard at 7:30 pm, seconded by W. Harrington and all voted yes.
