### **New Business**

**Situation 1:** Chief Dirsa brought a request from the Selectmen to review the locations of the speed limit signs around town as some roads “don’t have signs”.

**Recommendation:** Chief Lord will provide HFPD with paper town maps for the officers to mark up during patrol as to the locations and types of speed limit signs around town. D. Robinson will do an inventory of signs that are in-stock at the town shed. When the information is compiled, Chief Lord will create a document on Word to present to the HSC for review at the May 13<sup>th</sup> meeting with the possibility to pass along to the Selectmen on May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2013.

### **Old Business**

**Situation 1:** L. Anderson asked about the Chevron sign at Kensington Rd (Rt 84) and Goodwin Road and if Division 6 was ever going to replace it.

**Recommendation:** Request the Selectmen send a letter to NH DOT Division 6 to replace the chevron signs at the bottom of Goodwin Road at the intersection with Kensington Road (Rt 84) to help motorists realize they are at a ‘T’ intersection and reduce the amount of vehicles running across the road and crashing into the stone wall and utility pole.
