Meeting called to order at 7:33 am. Attendance: B.Mutrie, S.Volpone, D.Smith; A.Franciosa; C.Brown; P.Stone

Minutes from May 2 meeting approved. Motion to approve by A.Franciosa and by 2<sup>nd</sup> B.Mutrie. Vote 3-0.

### Community Planning Grant Program:

The only item on the agenda was the application for the above titled grant. C.Brown reported that Marietta Garavaglia agreed to assist in the writing of the subject grant with the proviso that she would be provided with all necessary research. Her function would be to assimilate the provided input into a responsive and readable grant document. D.Smith led the committee through the general process that would need to be followed. He also focused on our efforts to communicate our vision and goals, which the committee generally agreed were: economic development of the Rte 1 corridor; expansion of the tax base through commercial/industrial higher density zoning; preservation of the rural character of the town by addressing such amenities as streetscape plantings and pedestrian walkways. Various ideas were floated concerning bus service that would extend further south from Hampton to include Hampton Falls and Seabrook. It was further pointed out that any grant narrative should be consistent with the Town's Master Plan. It was agreed that input would be funneled to Marietta through email and/or C.Brown. D.Smith would provide a "template" application and appropriate talking points for our consideration.

### Selectmen Meeting [6/6/2012]:

The Planning Board would need the Selectmen to approve funding the Town's share of the project [less than \$2,000] should the Town receive the Grant. To this end the Planning Board [Ordinance and Regulation Committee] will make a short overview presentation at the next Selectmen meeting on Wednesday, June 6. The completed grant application must be post-marked submitted no later than June 15.
