Draft Workshop Minutes April 16, 2015

Present: Charlyn Brown, Chairman; Larry Smith; Marietta Garavaglia and Glenn Greenwood, RPC Consultant. Not present: Lisa Brown-Kucharski and Todd Santora.

The workshop began at 8:05 A.M. and ran for about one and one half hours.

Glenn handed out results of about 200 responses (approximately 20% of the households) to the survey. This input will be used in the updating of the Master Plan Chapters.

Discussion was held regarding the approach to be used for the Vision Chapter. It was decided to work on making arrangements for discussion groups from the residents of the Town. The committee hopes to be able to use the school for this purpose. Glenn will talk to the LAS principal to explain the process – one large meeting area and classrooms for rotating discussion groups with facilitators (from the RPC). This will be a fall activity. It was also decided to reach out to the residents to thank them for responding to the survey and to inform them that the Planning Board will be seeking further input through discussion groups to help with the vision for Hampton Falls for the next ten years. Marietta volunteered to put together a draft for the Town Newsletter.

In addition to the survey, Glenn also handed out outlines for both the Transportation and the Housing Chapters. As there is grant money that is available through June to help with the Transportation Chapter, the decision was made to immediately work on that chapter with the hopes to have it in draft form by the end of June. The committee members will review the outline handed out and also the current content in the Transportation Chapter in order to be able to begin re-writing (updating) that chapter at the next workshop.
