Meeting Minutes: 12/12/13 DRAFT

Opened meeting at 6:35 p.m. G. Schrempf made voting member for meeting.

Kay made a motion to pay the bill for \$887 from the Boy Scouts for maintaining the greenhead fly traps. 2nd from Robert. Passed unanimously.

Raspberry Farm – Reviewed the request by the Town to burn Christmas Trees as Raspberry Farm. Glenn suggested the lowest point between the parking lot and the ridge may be a good place to burn given that it tends to be wetter and therefore will prevent the fire from getting out of hand. The group had no restrictions beyond those requested by RCCD. Paul made a motion to allow Bobbi to write and send the letter requested by RCCD regarding tree burning. 2nd from Robert. Passed unanimously.

Discussed using ash on the fields next spring versus lime. Bobbi will contact RCCD to get pricing on renting their spreader and getting ash.

Group discussed new proposed zoning for Rt. 1 corridor. Much discussion centered around the area covered being far more than what presented to the Conservation Commission when the Planning Board Representative attended a Conservation meeting this past year.
