

HAMPTON FALLS CEMETERY TRUSTEE'S MEETING Final

November 9, 2010 Start, 7:10 P.M.

Present: L.Walker, S.Bryant and G.Swain

Minutes of the September meeting were read and corrections made.

OLD BUSINESS;

Because of a misunderstanding about how much of the fence at NEW west View was to be cleaned, the bill was increased to \$800.00.

NEW BUSINESS;

It was decided to put off any work at Pike cemetery until spring and get estimates for tree removal at all the cemeteries and try to do them all at one time.

S.Bryant suggested a sub-committee to work and do clean up in the spring.

L.Walker has talked to Maura Wisner about use of the trust funds.

S.Bryant, as a businessman, suggested he sit with L.Walker and E.Small to help determine the funds needed for the cemeteries next year.

L.Walker will attend the next selectmen's meeting to inform them of a need for another trustee.

S.Bryant questioned the need to keep all the very old bills and receipts, etc. from the New West View cemetery association. L.Walker will talk to E.Small about this. There is so much paper that the files allocated for the entire cemetery system are full of New West View paper work.

L.Walker received a thank you from Mrs. Hughes for having the New West View cemetery fence cleaned.

S.Bryant suggested the possibility of replacing the wooden fence at Oak Lawn, which is in need of repair, with white vinyl, which is easier to maintain.

G.Swain suggested that as a method of not losing any more than one year of trustee's minutes that at the end of each year the minutes be put into the cemetery files and a new book of minutes started.

G.Swain reported two burials in the New West View cemetery in the past month.
