OLD BUSINESS;

L. Walker has written a thank you note to C. Hayes for the work he did this spring repairing two lots and ruts in the cemeteries.

NEW BUSINESS;

A bill was received from J. Buell for \$678.57. The bill was still not done correctly and L. Walker and E. Hardee will meet with J. Buell to try to get it done correctly in the future.

L. Walker will write an article to appear in the town new letter about the work that has been done in Old Brookside cemetery.

E. Hardee has spoken to some of the neighbors around Hawes cemetery to get their OK to trim some of the trees.

L. Merrill called L. Walker asking permission to have her son install her family monument and corner posts on her lot.

L. Walker said she would like to get help again from the Rockingham County Correctional Facility again since they did such a good job at Old Brookside and will contact E. Small to see if this can be arranged.

E. Hardee will call Terry Knowles, Assistant Director of Charitable Trusts for help getting funds for cleaning the Gov. Weare monument in Old Brookside cemetery.

L. Walker will call S. Bryant to see if he has gotten any estimates for tree removal in the cemeteries.

R. Woodes has given L. Walker some pictures he took of the "abandoned" Cram cemetery on private property on Exeter Rd. It appears as though it is being cared for by the Chema family. Ms. Chema is a former Cram.
