OLD BUSINESS;

S. Bryant has received two bids for tree removal for the town cemeteries. One from Linnehan Landscaping and one from Knowles Landscaping. The most cost effective bid was from Linnehan.

L. Walker will contact R. Syphers to repair the broken stones at Pike and Hawes cemeteries after the trees have been removed.

A work party is scheduled for August 20, 2011 at the New West View cemetery to clear brush along the back cross road.

S. Bryant will contact D. Robinson and P. Fitzgerald to see if one of them will bring us a load of gravel to repair the main roadway in the New West View cemetery..

NEW BUSINESS;

S. Bryant recommended the bid for tree removal be given to Linnehan Landscaping , 2nd by E. Hardee. S. Bryant will contact Linnahan Landscaping to inform them they have been awarded the bid for tree removal.

The 2012 town cemeteries budget was worked on at length

L. Walker suggested that a file be kept for "feed back" from the public on cemetery conditions for future reference.

It was suggested that it be a priority to get all the stones in all the cemeteries up righted and repaired.

A discussion was held about getting J. Appell, a monuments conservator, from West Hartford, Ct. to come and look at our cemeteries and give us some suggestions for cleaning and restoring our gravestones.

The total budget for the cemeteries for 2012 being asked for is \$10,900.00

L. Walker went to Dover, N.H. ,and purchased the vinyl fence notcher from AAA Fencing
