

HAMPTON FALLS CEMETERIES TRUSTEES MEETING

Present: L. Walker, S. Bryant, E. Hardee and G. Swain

Minutes of the September meeting were read and accepted.

OLD BUSINESS:

E. Hardee will contact D. Robinson about removal of the old iron fence at the Pike cemetery.

S. Bryant will continue with his work at the Pike cemetery in the spring.

R. Sphyers will do the work on repairing the head stoned at Pike cemetery.

An estimate from AAA Fencing to replace the fence at Oak Lawn was deemed too high.

S. Bryant suggested we do the work ourselves.

Stone cleaning in all the cemeteries needs to be a long term project involving the use of a professional stone cleaner. Further discussion on this will be done during the winter months.

The 2012 budget will be \$5,300.00.

E. Hardee and L. Walker will work on the bidding for the mowing of the cemeteries for the 2012 season.

L. Walker will contact R. Sphyers about repairing the granite fence posts at the Pike cemetery.

NEW BUSINESS;

L. Walker will go to the selectmens meeting to request a monthly or quarterly report of available funds.

In the future, funds received from the 27 trust funds can be used to restore the stones on those lots.

A future project will be to try to identify as many old stones as possible. The sexton is currently working on an inventory of West View with plans to eventually do all the cemeteries.

L. Walker and S. Bryant will get and install the sign post for the Old Brookside cemetery.

L. Walker noted that the Hawes cemetery needed some brush removal.

It was voted to change the meeting night to the 1<sup>st</sup>. Tuesday of the month. Suggested by L. Walker and 2<sup>nd</sup> by S. Bryant.
