L. Marelli was welcomed by L. Walker to the meeting. L. Marelli was asked questions pertaining to the mowing and care of the cemeteries for the up coming season. He stated that he had already started spring clean-up. His fee is approximately \$17.00 per lot or \$9,141.00 for the season. His bill will be submitted monthly.

OLD BUSINESS;

The minutes of the March meeting were read and accepted with one correction.

L. Walker made a motion to reimburse the Unitarian church and R. Syphers for the cost of the necessary supplies to repair and clean the three stones at Old Brook Side cemetery plus \$200.00 for labor, (with appropriate receipts). Motion was seconded and passed.

E. Hardee will write a letter to Governor Lynch and former Governor Sunnu asking about available funds for former governors grave maintenance

NEW BUSINESS;

L. Walker will check with the town administrator about getting help from the R.C.H. C .again this summer, possibly in June, to clean more brush in New Brookside cemetery.

E.Hardee will be in touch with Ann from Seabrook library to get the information for the proper paper work we will need to get us started on a State Historical Site Registrar for the Old Brookside cemetery, as well as financial help.

L.Walker will send a notice to the Hampton Union asking those who have lots in town cemeteries to please remove their x-mas decorations and old pots before May 15, 2012. After that date anything remaining will be removed by the sexton and disposed of.

S. Bryant will see to the repair and replacement of the top of the Gov. Weare monument.

The sexton reported that there is a pine tree down on the fence at the back of Oak Lawn and also a broken stone near the front of the Revolutionary cemetery.
