A bill was received from G. Harvey and R. Syphers for purchase of supplies for the stone restoration per agreement.

L.Walker will get the paint/stain for sign posts.

NEW BUSINESS;

A letter was received from D. French asking if the Trustees would be interested in supporting a WI-FI connection in the Town Hall. E. Hardee made an affirmative motion and was seconded by L.Walker

J. Appell has started work on the stones in the Brookside cemeteries.
