

HAMPTON FALLS CEMETERY TRUSTEES MEETING      Draft

OLD BUSINESS;

The sexton was reminded to contact D. French about the stump killer he offered.

L. Walker has contacted Sgt. Bromoke at the Rockingham County House of Corrections requesting laborers again this fall. She was told they were booked for the season.

L. Walker reported that Mr. Appell had received his check for work done on cemetery stones.

The 2013 cemeteries budget is \$11,800.00. Of this amount \$6,900.00 will be from trust funds and \$4,900.00 to be raised by taxes.

G. Hardee has received two bids for work to be done on West View cemetery and is waiting for the third bid before submission to the trustees.

L. Walker revealed that Pike cemetery does not seem to have been mowed this season by Mr. Birdsall's caretakers as in the past. She has tried to contact Mr. Birdsall about a tree limb overhanging the cemetery without success.

L. Walker has also contacted Mr. R. Syphers about finishing work on Pike cemetery.

NEW BUSINESS;

L. Walker made a motion to hold future meetings in the afternoon on the first Thursday of the month at 1:00 P.M., starting with the October meeting. Seconded by E. Hardee. Motion passed.

L. Walker said she has a person interested in becoming a trustee and invited him to the meeting tonight. He was not present.

L. Walker noted that both West View and Dodge have shrubs that need to be trimmed. G. Swain will see that it is taken care of.
