OLD BUSINESS;

Minutes of the December meeting were read and accepted.

L. Walker received a letter from D. French of the Historical Society about the sign they are going to purchase for us.

The large limb which blew down in the October storm has been removed at the Old Brookside cemetery L. Marelli.

L. Walker will send a thank you note to R. Syphers thanking him for the excellent work he did at the Pike cemetery.

An estimate was received from R. Syphers to repair the granite post at Pike cemetery.

A motion was made by L. Walker and seconded by S. Bryant to do no further work on the Pike cemetery until spring or summer.

Further investigation will be needed to finish repair work on the Gov. Weare monument. Also a spring project.

L. Walker has talked to T.Samway about a file cabinet. He has a friend who is willing to give us one he no longer needs.

L. Walker has told us that most of the stones at Old Brookside can be cleaned with water and a soft brush and that not all the stones need to be cleaned.

Work will continue next spring on Old and New Brookside cemeteries next spring and summer to restore their proper boundaries.

All cemetery sign posts will be painted gray next summer.

The work on the fence at Oaklawn cemetery will be postponed until a later date.
