

HAMPTON FALLS CEMETERY TRUSTEE'S MEETING Draft

Present: L. walker, J.Bohm and G. Swain

Minutes of the March meeting were read and corrections made.

OLD BUSINESS:

L.Walker reviewed the funds still available from FEMA. \$2,290.00 Should these funds not be fully used they are to be returned to the town.

L.Walker will send a letter to Mrs. Birdsall concerning Pike cemetery and its future maintenance.

The letter L.Walker sent to Mrs Rouleau concerning her desire to re-sell her cemetery lot to the town was returned to her by the post office. We will have to wait for Mrs. Rouleau to contact us again.

We did not receive a definite response from the Rockingham County House of Corrections in our request for help in the cleaning of cemeteries again this year. We therefore need to get a group of town people interested in helping out

NEW BUSINESS:

G.Swain reported that a tall stone in the Dodge cemetery broke apart during the winter. This stone has been repaired in the past. L.Walker requested J. Bohm to contact R.Syphers to get a repair estimate.

L.walker informed us that the town has been paying a \$12.45 deed recording fee to the county for each cemetery lot sold. L.Walker. made a motion that this fee in the future beginning June 1, 2013 is to be paid by the buyer at the time of the sale of a cemetery lot. With a second check to cover this fee, made out to the town of Hampton Falls Cemetery Maintenance Fund. Motion was seconded by J.Bohm.

L.Walker received an estimate of \$9,145.00 from L.Marelli for mowing the cemeteries this coming season.

L. Walker will put an article in the town news letter/local paper for people to remove winter decorations from their lots before April 30th if they wish to keep them. Otherwise they will be removed and disposed of in the process of cemetery clean-up for Memorial day.
