

HAMPTON FALLS CEMETERY TRUSTEES MEETING      Draft

Present; L. Walker, J. Bohm, E. Hardee and G. Swain

Minutes of the April meeting were read and accepted.

OLD BUSINESS:

- L. Walker sent a letter to Mrs Birdsall stating that effective April 8, 2013 the Pike cemetery will no longer be considered a town cemetery, but a private cemetery as per the deed to the property.

E.Hardee reported that Maj. Blomke informed him there would be on help available from Rockingham County Corrections inmates this year as they are fully booked.

J. Bohm met with R.Syphers at the Dodge cemetery where they found four broken stones. An estimate of \$1,100.00 was given for repairs. G. Hardee made a motion to have them repaired. Motion was seconded by L. Walker. J. Bohm will contact R. Syphers to proceed with repairs. Monies to come from Restoration of Gravestone Funds; 4909-353.

A motion was made by L. Walker to add to by-laws effective 6-1-2013 a separate check fee for burial lots to cover the cost of recording fees at Rockingham County Deeds registry. Motion was seconded by J. Bohm. The motion was withdrawn when sexton G. Swain discovered that this action was already in the by-laws but apparently had never been accessed in the past. L. Walker will inform the Town Clerk of the extra fee collection.

The trustees committee and sexton will meet on Monday May 5, 2013 for a clean-up secession at Oak Lawn cemetery at 10:00 A.M.

NEW BUSINESS;

- L. Walker will contact the Lincoln Akerman School to try to get school children to help with cleaning the Brookside cemeteries again this year.

Meeting adjourned at 2:30 P.M. Next meeting will be June 6, 2013.
