A brief pre meeting was held for a discussion with Mrs Powell , concerning her mother lot which she would like to exchange for another space in New Brookside cemetery.

OLD BUSINESS;

The August meeting minutes of the 15th and 22nd were read and accepted.

Jonathan Bohm will fill L.Walkers vacancy and become chairman of the committee. Forest Brown has been sworn in as a new member.

NEW BUSINESS;

J.Bohm received a letter from Tracy Healey Beatty noting that shrubs in the Oak Lawn at the ends of the public bench needed trimming. The sexton will take care of this.

T.H.Beatty also inquired if she could be buried on her family property . State law allows this with certain restrictions. A copy of the RSA laws will be sent to her and also one to B.Powell_woodward who has made a similar request.

A viewing of Oak Lawn cemetery by the committee will take place on Sept.17, 2013 at 10;00 a.m.

A discussion of the by-laws was held and it was determined that a part of the sentence in Chapter 3 , paragraph 5: should be changed to read;, four (4) corner markers are to be installed by the owner of the plot . Rather than by the town as it now reads. Motion to make the change was made by F.Brown and seconded by E.Hardee.

L.Walker was asked to attend future meetings in an advisory position.
