Minutes

A Public Hearing by the Hampton Falls Cemetery Trustees in accordance with RSA 31:39 I (a) was held at the Town Hall on October 15, 2013, at 1:00 p.m. for the purpose of converting an existing right of way between lots 16 & 22 to a burial plot.

Present were Jonathan Bohm, chairman, and Forrest Brown—trustees. Absent were Geno Hardee, trustee and Georgianna Swain, secretary.

The trustees discussed putting two gravesites in an existing right of way between plots 16 and 22 in New Brookside. Louise Merrill (the only member of the public present) spoke in opposition to this proposal. Following the completion of the remaining business, the trustees along with Louise Merrill went to New Brookside to view what the trustees were proposing. After listening to L. Merrill's concerns, the trustees voted and approved the plan to place two gravesites in an existing right of way between plots 16 and 22.

Roger Rouleau requested to have a gravesite he previously had purchased in Oak Lawn Cemetery be returned to the Hampton Falls Cemetery Trustees. It will be recorded in the Registry of Deeds and \$495.00 will be refunded to Mr. Rouleau.

The trustees also voted to exchange two lots that P. Powell and L. Bush had previously purchased in New Brookside for two gravesites in Oak Lawn Cemetery. The lots had become covered with brush and trees and Powell and Bush felt these lots were now undesirable burial sites even though the trees and brush were recently cleared.

The meeting adjourned at 2:30 p.m.
