

HAMPTON FALLS CEMETERY TRUSTEES MEETING draft

November 5, 2013 1:10 P.M.

Present: J. Bohm, E. Hardee, F. Brown G. Swain and L.Walker.

Minutes of the October meeting were read and accepted.

OLD BUSINESS;

The request from A.Rouleau to return their lot in Oak Lawn cemetery to the town was granted and they were paid \$495.00.

F.Brown reported the had used a bio-degradable cleaner called "wet and Forget" to clean the fence at New West View cemetery.

D. Robinson has been paid for his work at the New Brookside cemetery.

E. Hardee has met with D.Robinson to try to resolve the drainage issue at Oak Lawn cemetery.

NEW BUSINESS:

L.Marelli submitted his bill for the 2013 mowing season, \$9,145.00. This will be paid with funds from Account #4195-430.

The Busch lot in New Brookside has been exchanged for a lot in another area of the cemetery following a public meeting for the request of the exchange.

E. Hardee will arrange a meeting with D.Robinson and L.Marelli to solve the drainage issue at Oak Lawn as it is caused by street water run-off into the cemetery.

F.Brown reported that he has fixed the fencing at New West View several times this past season. It was suggested that we have L. Marelli use our notcher tool to fix the fencing. E.Hardee will talk to him about it. AAA Fencing will be used if L.Marelli is unable to do it.

J.Bohm submitted a bill for \$109.14 for advertizing for the public hearing concerning the Busch lot. Motion made to pay by F.Brown and seconded by E.Hardee.

G. Swain reported meeting with the Heritage Commission to discuss her cemetery related project of cataloging interments in all the cemeteries in town. They would like to offer help in the project, especially in the GPS mapping of cemeteries as a part of the upcoming 300<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the town.
