OLD BUSINESS:

F. Brown reported that L. Marelli has agreed to repair the fence at new West View cemetery.

NEW BUSINESS:

J. Bohm will attend the next Selectmen meeting and broach the subject of who will pay for the drainage to be installed along the road side of West View cemetery as the currant drainage affects the cemetery property.

F. Brown was approached by a person willing to pay for installation of a water hydrant in Oak Lawn cemetery.

J. Bohm reported that the Selectmen have been authorized to accept an amount up to \$5,000.00 for the above project.

F. Brown suggested we get an estimate and contact donor to see if he wants to remain anonymous or if he would like a plaque.

J. Bohm will send a letter to the donor concerning this and to provide a paper trail.

J. Bohm received a request for more trees in the Oak Lawn cemetery, to which he explained the reason for not having them ( roots ). This was discussed at the meeting and was suggested that a few dwarf trees could be donated to place in areas that would not interfere with the actual burial area..

F. Brown suggested a new sign for New West View cemetery as the existing one is a small engraved sign on one of the gate post and is differ cult to see. F. Brown made this a motion and it was seconded by J. Bohm.

J. Bohm made a motion to recommend T. Healey-Beattie as member of the Trustees, motion was seconded by F. brown. J. Bohm will attend the next Selectmen meeting with our recommendation.

F. Brown reported that the town cemeteries are now on the Hampton Falls web site.

Complaints have been received by various members of the committee about the ruts in the road ways in New West View cemetery . F. Brown will look into this matter.
