OLD BUSINESS:

The water has been installed at the Oak Lawn Cemetery and F. Brown has seeded and mulched the area. The bill for the well exceeded the \$750.00 gift received for the project. Unforeseen piping problems increased the cost by \$438.00, plus \$33.94 for the seed and mulch.

J. Bohm made a motion to pay the \$33.94 bill owed to Dodges Agway from the Cemetery Maintenance Fund. 2nd by F. Brown.

It was decided to table the drainage for Oak Lawn until next years budget is established.

NEW BUSINESS;

J. Bohm contacted J. Fermery to attend this meeting to discuss his "Tree plan" for Oak Lawn Cemetery.

J. Bohm informed embers that the cemetery budget for next year must be submitted by September 8, 2014. We will work on it at the next meeting.

F. Brown reported that he has not yet been able to make arrangements for road leveling in West View cemetery.

T. Healy_Beattie spoke to R. Russell about a plaque for the water in Oak Lawn. He O. Ke.d a small one in memory of his wife. T. Healy-Beattie will also contact various sign companies to get prices for the plaque also installation on a stone.

A new sign similar to the ones identifying the other cemeteries in tow is needed for West View cemetery.

F. Brown reported that L. Marelli has repaired the vinyl fencing rails in West View.
