OLD BUSINESS:

J. Bohm reported he presented the 2017 budget to the selectmen It is \$6,895.00 more than the previous year.

NEW BUSINESS:

F. Brown presented a report of the interest accrued in the trust funds for perpetual care lots in New West View. \$13,635.00 are available.

T. Healey-Beattie presented the newest report from G. Woodworth on her restoration work in Old Brook side and Dodge cemeteries.

T. Healey-Beattie also presented the article she has written for submission to the Hampton Falls Magazine about the dedication of the plaque to the founders of the Oak Lawn cemetery.

G. Swain suggested the cemetery committee should look into having the Old Brook Side cemetery designated a Historical Site in keeping with the up coming tri-centennial and the fact that the town and the old cemetery are the sites of resident of the first governor (president) of the state of N.H..

Pauper lots were discussed. Apparently it is up to the town to pay for burial expenses but the question is whether or not the town must purchase a lot. J. Bohm will look into this.

F. Brown informed us he has the missing rail from the Oak Lawn fence which he is repairing.
