

HAMPTON FALLS CEMETERY TRUSTEES MEETING Draft

Present: J. Bohm, F. Brown, T.H. Beattie, G. Swain and R. Russell, guest.

Minutes of the June meeting were read and accepted.

OLD BUSINESS:

T. H. Beattie will check with G. Woodworth about a possible rain date for her demonstration Scheduled for Saturday July 9, 2016 at 9:00 A.M.

J. Bohm received a call from the Major at the Rockingham County Prison informing him prisoners would be available for work after the second week in August.

It was noted that the new plaque has been delivered and installed and flowers have been planted behind it.

J. Bohm received an estimate for \$2,250.00 for lime and fertilizer for all the cemeteries from "Going Green" our cemetery maintenance co. Discussion followed, T.H.Beattie voted in favor, it was seconded by F. Brown to accept.

T.H. Beattie discussed a 501C fund with the trustees for donation monies for tree purchases for Oak Lawn Cemetery. R. Russell will contact N.H.M.A. to see is we can do this and have a separate account from the town funds.

R. Russell has purchased four elm trees for the Oak Lawn cemetery; they will come with large water fillable bags for a steady drip system to provide water.

The article for the 2017 budget/warrant was discussed and postponed until the August meeting.

J. Bohm noted that we have to use the monies for the new fencing at Oak Lawn and stone repair Before November 1, 2016, as next year's budget begins then.

R. Robinson has not installed the drain pipe in front of Oak Lawn or scraped the roads in West View yet. He says it will be done as soon as town road repair is finished.

NEW BUSINESS:

It was decided the dedication of our new plaque will be held in the fall when the work on Oak Lawn is finished.
